

Privacy Policy

Effective Date 26th April 2018

In this document we describe how Let's Eat collects, uses and shares information when you access and use the Let's Eat mobile Application and Services.

We take the private nature of your personal information very seriously, and are committed to protecting it.

1. User Data

How we collect and store information depends on the Services you use and your device settings.

- You can use some of the Services in the Application without Logging in or providing any user identification. In these cases we may still automatically collect some user data relating to your device as described below.
- If you log in and you use the Application to make post/reviews, comments or votes then we may collect additional information specific to those post/reviews, comments and votes as described below.
- In addition to the data provided via the device we may also collect public data about you available from the Steem Blockchain from previous public; post/reviews, comments, and other interactions that you have made there.

This Application may contain links to other sites. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that site. These external sites are not operated by Let's Eat therefore it is important that you review the Privacy Policy of these websites before using them. It is those sites' responsibility to protect any information you give them, so Let's Eat can't be held liable for their wrongful use of your personally identifying information.

2. How We Collect Information

2.1 Information collected automatically

When you access or use our Application, we may automatically collect information about you. This includes:

2.1.1 Log and Usage Data

- When you use the application we primarily collect non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers, servers, and services like Google Analytics typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the time of each visit. Other

non-identifying information that we might have access to includes how you use the Service (e.g. search queries), your approximate location, cookies, etc.

- If you log in with the Application we may additionally collect and store your Steem Username, Links to post/reviews and Comments Submitted, Votes and Images submitted.

2.1.2 Location Information

With your consent, we may collect information about the specific location of your mobile device (for example, by using GPS or Bluetooth). You can revoke this consent at any time by changing the preferences on your device, but doing so may affect your ability to use all of the features and functionality of our Application.

2.2 Information collected manually

2.2.1 Blockchain Data

We may also collect publicly available information from the Steem Blockchain about users of the Application such as posting history (post/reviews, Comments, post/review Tags), account information (Steem Tokens, Steem Reputation) , as well as user interactions (votes and follows)

3. How We Use Information About You

We use information about you to:

- Provide, maintain, and improve the Services that we provide
- Help protect the safety of Let's Eat and our Users, which includes blocking suspected spammers and enforcing the Let's Eat Terms of Service agreement
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities in connection with our Application
- Personalize the Application and provide content and features that match the User profiles or interests
- Aggregate and publish anonymised usage statistics for marketing and promotional material.

4. How We Share Information

When you use the Application Services, certain information may be shared with other users and the public via the Steem Blockchain. The Steem Blockchain is a global public decentralised peer to peer network/database/blockchain therefore any data you submit to it will be shared globally to anyone with access to this network.

ANY INFORMATION THAT HAS BEEN PUBLISHED TO THE STEEM BLOCKCHAIN WILL REMAIN INDEFINITELY.

When you login and authorise the Application via Steemconnect, or submit a post/review, image, comment or vote in the Application, visitors to and users of our Application and the Steem Blockchain will be able to see the content of your post/reviews, comments and votes, the username associated with your post/reviews, comments and votes, and the date and time you submitted the post/review, comment or vote. Although some parts of the Application Services may be private or quarantined, they may become public and you should take that into consideration before posting with the Application.

When other users view your public profile on the Steem Blockchain, they will be able to see information about your activities with the Application, such as your username, prior post/reviews, comments and votes, your Steem tokens, and when you authorised the app via Steemconnect.

Please note that, even when you delete your account from third party services, the post/reviews, comments, images and messages you submit through the Let's Eat application may still be available on the Steem Blockchain.

Apart from data and images that is sent by the User to the Steem Blockchain, we will not share, sell, or give away any of our users' other personal information to third parties, unless one of the following circumstances applies:

- We may share information (and will attempt to provide you with prior notice, to the extent legally permissible) in response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with, or required by, any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request
- We may share information if we believe your actions are inconsistent with our user agreements, or other Let's Eat policies, or to protect the rights, property, and safety of ourselves and others
- We may share information with your consent or at your direction
- We may share aggregated or de-identified information, which cannot reasonably be used to identify you in particular for marketing purposes.

We use analytic partners (such as Google Analytics and Firebase) to help analyse usage and traffic for our Application. As an example, we may use analytics partners to analyse and measure, in aggregate, the number of unique visitors to our Application or the geographical usage.

We will analyse the public posting and transaction history of Users on the Steem Blockchain to understand their preferences and improve Services and deliver more relevant content via the Application.

5. Location of your Data

Some of your data such as photographs and post links will be stored on cloud servers (AWS) which may be in jurisdictions outside the EU. By submitting a photograph or a post with the Application you will be sending data to one of these servers.

Users of the device are based globally and they can access any public data that you have posted via the Application. We will also share photographs you have posted via the application with anyone who accesses the Application, or views the reviews/posts via other applications such as steemit.com.

6. Account Information

You may view content in the Let's Eat Application without an account however if you wish to make a post/review or comment you will need a Steem Account which is provided from the Steem Blockchain. Let's Eat does not create accounts on the Blockchain or store any private account data or passwords. If you wish to delete your Steem account you would need to contact the provider that created the account for you.

Let's Eat has no way of knowing that an account has been deleted and we may retain certain information about you as required by law or for legitimate business purposes even after you delete your account with third party providers

ANY INFORMATION THAT HAS BEEN PUBLISHED TO THE STEEM BLOCKCHAIN WILL REMAIN INDEFINITELY. DELETING YOUR ACCOUNT WILL NOT REMOVE CONTENT WHICH IS STORED ON THE STEEM BLOCKCHAIN.

7. Changes

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we do, we will let you know by revising the date at the top of the policy. If we make a change to this policy that, in our sole discretion, is material, we will provide you with additional notice (such as adding a statement to @letseat account on steemit.com). We encourage you to review the Privacy Policy whenever you access or use our Services or otherwise interact with us to stay informed about our information practices and the ways you can help protect your privacy. If you continue to use our Services after Privacy Policy changes go into effect, you consent to the revised policy.
